Madison Little League -- Coaching Requirements -- Due Date: March 15

All coaches are required to submit the following documents before the season begins.

Documents can be found at the Forms & Links page of our website.

- 1. Volunteer Application (with Social Security #).
 - NOTE: Returning coaches can fill out the "Returning Volunteer Application".
- 2. Copy of valid driver's license.
- 3. Copy of valid National Youth Sports Coaches Association (NYSCA) Card. The card must be valid through at least June of the season in which you are coaching; if your current card expires in March, you must renew it.
 - a. Returning Coaches Renew certification online with NYSCA at NAYS.org.
 - b. First Time Coaches Must take two online courses on the NAYS website:
 - (1) Coaching Youth Sports and (2) Sport Specific Training Baseball & T-Ball. If you are already a NYSCA member for a different sport, you only need to take course (2).
 - Go to NAYS.org
 - Click on "Training & Membership"
 - Click on "Coaches"
 - Click on "Training" on the left side
 - Click on "NYSCA Online Clinics" and sign up to take the online classes. You will
 need to watch all videos and take the test at the end.

After you take these two online classes a NYSCA Card will be sent to you. There is a \$20 fee for your NYSCA membership which you must pay at the time you take the online training.
