

Madison Little League -- Coaching Requirements -- Due Date: March 15

All documents can be found at the [Forms & Links](#) page of our website.

All managers and coaches are required to submit the following documents by March 15:

1. Volunteer Application
2. Copy of valid driver's license
3. Copy of valid National Youth Sports Coaches Association (NYSCA) Card.

The NYSCA card must be valid through at least June of the season in which you are coaching; if your current card expires in March, you must renew it.

- a. Returning Coaches - Renew certification online with NYSCA at NAYS.org.
- b. First Time Coaches - Must take online courses on the NAYS website:

(1) *Coaching Youth Sports* AND

(2) *Baseball 8 & Under* - OR - *Baseball 9+* (depending on the age group you are coaching)

Additional Notes:

- You will need to watch all videos and take the test at the end.
- If you are already a NYSCA member for another sport, you only need to take course (2).
- We also recommend taking *Concussion Training* (but this course is not required).
- After you take the required courses, a NYSCA Card will be sent to you. You can also download a copy of the card from the NYSCA website.
- There is a \$20 fee for your NYSCA membership that must be paid at the time you take the online training.
